Tee-Ball Rules

- 1. The home team is listed second on the schedule and will occupy the 1st base dugout. They are responsible for bringing the tee.
- 2. Batters and base runners must wear helmets at all times.
- 3. No throwing his or her helmet.
- 4. All players must sit on the bench when not actively involved in the game. Coaches are to be in control of their teams. Only players and coaches are allowed to sit on the bench.
- 5. Two defensive coaches are allowed in the outfield to assist players but must not interfere with play.
- 6. If the ball and tee are hit simultaneously, it is playable as long as it is not foul.
- 7. The defensive team must throw the ball to the pitcher to stop play. The catcher must have control of the ball. Time is called when the play is complete. Runners will be advanced or sent back at the decision of the coaches.
- 8. The coaches are in charge of the game their call on all plays is final. No protests are allowed. Please remember sportsmanship and professional conduct if a conflict should arise.
- 9. The LRC shall place all players on teams.
- 10. Game length is 3 innings or 50 minutes.
- 11. Every player will bat each inning prior to changing sides.
- 12. All defensive players will be on the field.
- 13. No official score is kept
- 14. No leadoffs, no overthrows and no stealing.
